Kaltura Defined

- Kaltura is a media portal
 - Users can create and store video content
 - Edit their own content
 - Manage and share content
- Kaltura includes a Blackboard interface, allowing users to upload video content to their courses



Kaltura Defined

- Content options include:
 - Uploaded media content
 - Recorded Zoom sessions
 - Short screen-capture videos
 - Voice-annotated PowerPoint slides
 - Webcam recordings
 - Integrated quizzes
 - Students can use Kaltura too



Applications

- Engage students with media-rich content and quizzes
- Resource for developing a flipped classroom environment
- Upload video content to Blackboard using the Kaltura interface
- Students can record and post responses to discussion boards, blogs, wikis and journals

Best Practices

■ Storyboard

- Annotate mouse or cursor movements that coincide with the words
- Rehearse the script and screen interactions
- Edit the storyboard to reflect any changes made during rehearsal

Best Practices

- Open all applications that interact with the recording
- Clear your computer desktop
- Turn off phones, fans and email reminders
- When using the webcam, take note of the background

Best Practices

- Use the Firefox browser on both Mac and PC
- Keep the video length under five minutes
- Make a test recording
