Learning Module

- A Learning Module is an organized collection of content presented together. Content within a Learning Module is added and managed just like in any folder in a Content Area.
- The Learning Module is a shell to which other content items such as files, folders and tools are added.

Content in Learning Module

- You can include the following in a Learning Module:
 - Introduction for the week
 - Content Items - Files
 - Folders
 - URLs (external links)
 - Mashups (multimedia)
 - Tests and Surveys
 - Assignments
 - Discussion Board Forums
 - Other Tools

Learning Module Example

- Introduction and Module Objectives
- Content Items (Lecture files)
- Mashups (One or more links to external web sites)
- One written assignment or one test
- One graded discussion
- Overview of the week ahead
