


Stata and the vLab

By downloading the vLab application (VMware Client) to your computer, you are able to access all of the tools and features of the vLab. This tool on your computer is essential in quickly accessing Stata. The VMware Client allows users to save documents to their computer hard drive or the OneDrive.

Download the vLab Application




1. Open a browser and navigate to <http://vlab.uiwtx.edu>
2. Click **Download the Horizon Client for Windows (x64)**



3. On the *Download the VMware Horizon Clients* page, locate the client for your operating system. **Choose from Windows, Mac, Linux, Android, IOS or Chrome.**
4. For *Windows*, choose **VMware Horizon Client for Windows**
5. Select **Go to Downloads** on the right



6. A new page opens. Click **Download** and **save** the file to your desktop.




7. Click **Agree and Install**, then follow the prompts to install the software. There will be several prompts. You will need to *restart your computer* when the installation is complete.


Install and Access the Application




1. When this icon appears on your desktop, the installation is complete. Click the **VMware Horizon icon** to install the application


2. Click **Add Server**

3. On the next menu, type in the **vLab address: vlab.uiwtx.edu**
 4. Click **Connect**

5. Enter your **UIW credentials** (*username and password*)
 6. Click **Login**




7. Click the **vlab@everywhere icon**




8. The Vlab page opens. Click **Start** to begin using vLab


Open and Save Stata Datasets in vLab




1. Clicking **Start** opens up the *Start Menu*
2. Locate *Stata16* on the list, then choose **IBM StataMP16 (64-bit)**




3. Open your dataset by clicking the **Documents drop down** and locate a folder named *yourusername on UIW-XXXX*. This number matches your computer's address. The Dataset will be saved to your desktop. **(There will be a folder named for your username, do not use this folder)**
4. **Note:** You can open datasets from the desktop or the OneDrive, just locate the *OneDrive at University of the Incarnate Word* folder
5. Click **Open**



6. After opening your dataset, click **File**
7. Click **Save As**



8. Click the **Documents drop down** and locate the same folder (*yourusername on UIW-XXXX*)
9. **Note:** If the dataset was opened from the OneDrive, choose the folder named *F on UIW-XXXX*
10. Click **Save**
11. Continue to save the document as you modify the dataset by clicking **Save**. The document will save to the same folder.



12. To exit the vLab, click **Log Off**
13. **Note:** Any documents saved to the vLab desktop will be **deleted**.
